What is Arkansas JSHS?

The Arkansas Junior Science and Humanities Symposium (JSHS) is a research competition that serves as the regional qualifier for National JSHS competition. JSHS gives you the opportunity to present your original research and compete at a professional level for scholarships and recognition at the Junior Science and Humanities Symposium (JSHS). JSHS is open to high school students in grades 9-12. Students are invited to present results from their original STEM research investigations to a forum of peer and practicing researchers at this regional symposia.

Two presentation options:

Oral Presentation

- Requires registration and submission of full paper by February 1st
- 12 papers will be selected by a panel of expert judges
- Top 3 oral presenters are awarded scholarships to a school of their choice
- Top 5 winners in the oral competition are awarded a trip to the National JSHS April 15-18, 2020, in Norfolk, Virginia to present their research with the opportunity to earn additional scholarships

Poster Presentation

- Advanced registration is requested by March 1st
 - Advanced registration is not required, poster presenters may register the day of the event
- Full paper submission is not required
- Cash prizes are awarded for top poster presenters
- Up to two Arkansas Tech University scholarships will be awarded to poster presenter winners

How much does it cost?

Nothing! Arkansas JSHS funding covers registration fees, meals, and lodging for you and chaperones while you are at the event. Students/schools are responsible for transportation to the event.
