Sponsors and additional STEM-related exhibitors will join students in the rotunda.

Frequently Asked Questions

1. What happens at AR STEM @The Capitol Day?
 - a. Student team display projects in rotunda (all day)
 - b. Student teams meet with legislators (throughout day)
 - c. Press conference (10:30 AM)
 - d. Presentation of Governor's Proclamation (Tentatively 10:00 AM)
 - e. Student teams recognized during House and Senate sessions (afternoon convening, typically 1:30 PM)
2. Who attends AR STEM @The Capitol Day?
 - a. A wide variety of people attend, including constitutional officers, legislators, lobbyists, business representatives, students, teachers, school administrators, higher education representatives, nonprofit organizations, the press, and public visitors.
3. Who can become a sponsor?
 - a. Any entity or person can be a sponsor of AR STEM @The Capitol Day!
4. As a sponsor, can I choose a school or students to participate in AR STEM @The Capitol Day?
 - a. No. The EAST Initiative chooses the schools that will represent each region. Participating students are involved in EAST at their schools.
5. Where are student teams coming from this year?
 - a. The EAST Initiative student teams will be selected from all five regions of the state (Central, Northwest, Northeast, Southwest, and Southeast). The schools will be announced by the end of 2025.
6. Is lunch included with my sponsorship?
 - a. Yes, two box lunches are included for each sponsor who RSVPs by the deadline. You will have your choice from a limited menu.
